
- Lake Oroville at 47% of historical average

COMPLIANCE DATES

- \$25K or less (three year average) exempt
- \$25K \$250K January 26, 2020
- \$250K \$500K January 26, 2019
- \$500K and Up January 26, 2018



ENFORCEMENT

CDFA enforcing on behalf of FDA
Inspection and enforcement begins 2019
If earlier compliance required, must show 2018 compliance through record keeping



FOOD SAFETY FOCUS

- People hygiene and health
- Water hand washing, water supply, runoff
- Soil amendments, prior use, adjacent uses
- Animals wild and domestic
