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2020 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Farm Bureau of San Diego County is committed to assisting students to complete their education in agriculture/horticulture or a closely related field. Each year scholarships are awarded to worthy students. Primary criteria for awards are career goals, work experience, financial need, grades and written expression. Secondary criteria are extracurricular activities and academic honors.

"Due to the current COVID-19 crisis and government restrictions, the deadline for submitting completed scholarship applications will be postponed to May 22nd. Also, we are requesting that you send at least one teacher/work recommendation, in recognition that obtaining two recommendations during this shut down may not be possible."

Eligibility requirements:

Any student entering or attending a two-year or four-year college or university is eligible. Applicants must be pursuing a course of study in agriculture/horticulture or a closely related field, and they *must have a permanent residence in San Diego County*. Membership in the Farm Bureau is not required.

General Information:

Scholarship award amounts have ranged from \$500 to \$5,000 in past years. Funds awarded in 2020 must be applied to the 2020-2021 academic year. Each student who wins a scholarship will be notified by mail.

Scholarship awards will be based on information provided in the completed application form. Previous applicants and former scholarship recipients may re-apply in future years by submitting an updated application, transcript, and recommendations.

Scholarship funds will be deposited at the educational institution in the recipient's name and applied by that institution to the student's expenses.

Required Supporting Documents:

- 1. A recommendation from a teacher/academic advisor at your school evaluating you as a student (*please use enclosed form*). A recommendation from a parent is not acceptable. The teacher or applicant should mail or fax the completed form to the Farm Bureau office. *
- 2. A recommendation from a current or former employer or community service organization evaluating you as a worker or volunteer (please use enclosed form). A recommendation from a parent or teacher is not acceptable. The recommender or applicant should mail or email (kathy@sdfarmbureau.org) the completed form to the Farm Bureau office. *
- 3. A transcript of grades from your most recent school. Grade point average must be calculated to a 4.0 scale. Photocopies are acceptable. Include transcript with completed application form. *

Deadline:

Applications must include responses to all essay questions and be postmarked by <u>May 22, 2020</u>. If mailing please use a large envelope, if possible, to avoid folding.
