SAN DIEGO COUNTY FARM BUREAU ENDORSES KEVIN FAULCONER FOR DISTRICT 3 COUNTY SUPERVISOR

ESCONDIDO, CA – The San Diego County Farm Bureau today announced their endorsement of Kevin Faulconer for San Diego County Supervisor in the upcoming March election in District 3.
